
Topic: MEANING MAKING IN THE TIMES OF CORONA

According to Dr. Chatterjee the important points to avoid the stress are:

Prof. Das first explained various atmospheric and geographical terminologies. He clearly explained that the cryosphere is the part of the Earth's climate system that includes solid precipitation, snow, sea ice, lake and river ice, icebergs, glaciers and ice caps, ice sheets, ice shelves, permafrost, and seasonally frozen ground. He then went on to explain the cause of warming of cryosphere and its lethal effect on environment. He also shared his experience and research works from South Pole Expedition in 2019.

All Students and teachers of Physics departments and other faculty members from Mathematics department attended the seminar.




